**-THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM: Lion Past Pres. White intro'ed Lamar Eidson & Madiene Gibson for a program on "KIDS AGAINST HUNGER".**

Lamar, who is a Temple native and retired from American Airlines, founded the local chapter of "KIDS AGAINST HUNGER" in July 2009.. This is an international effort to provide nutritious meals to children around the world. In 2006, an estimated 9.2 million children died of hunger or hunger related causes. An estimated 80% were in African counties. "Kids Against Hunger", was founded in 1999 by Richard Proudfit, a retired businessman. The organization hopes to package & ship over 80 million meals in the next year. After 3 years of study, the organization has developed a meal that is easy to mix, package and serve. It is made up mainly of rice, with 21 vitamins, minerals & proteins which are critical to maintaining health. Each meal can feed 6 children. The meals are mixed & packaged by volunteers from the local community chapters of "Kids Against Hunger".

There currently are 73 distribution centers around the world. A recent shipment of meals to Haiti was aided by the US Coast Guard.

The overall goal of the program is to feed every hungry child around the world. Even expectant mothers are fed in order to give their unborn children a leg up on good health. Over 90% of donated funds go to actually providing meals!!

The name, "Kids Against Hunger" implies another goal, and that is to encourage local kids to be a part of the mixing and packaging of meals. Instilling the value of "giving" is a gift for life for any child. Our local chapter has already served close to 150,000 meals!! Packaging events are held locally and Lamar will keep us posted. Thanks Lion White and Lamar Eidson.
