## THIS WEEKS PROGRAM

Lion Michael Haynes, Ph.D., author, chaplain, and counselor, introduced his wife, Marge Haynes, who helped give us a stirring presentation on the aftermath of the 911 attacks at ground zero. If you missed this, I'm sorry; I won't do it justice here. Marge began by performing a Christian song she wrote shortly after their work at ground zero entitled *Turn Your Eyes on Me*. It was accompanied by a very vivid and telling slideshow.

On September 11, 2001, Michael ironically, was conducting a CE course for workers involved with grief counseling. Two days later, Michael was at ground zero and working as a police chaplain providing counseling to workers. He remained there for a year. During that time, he experienced events, emotions, and situations that would change his life forever, physically and spiritually. Upon his arrival, his most vivid memories were the nine-story pile of burning rubble, the intense heat, the overwhelming stench and workers overcome with emotion. His primary activity was working with the "bucket brigade" to find survivors and to recover bodies. The only bodies found intact were in the stairwell of the towers; much of the remains were merely parts to be collected and sent to the city morgue. A fireman working with the brigade gave each man a fireman's angel, a pin to wear and protect them. In the nearby customs building, later renamed "God's House" by those who took their breaks there, workers found a large beam that formed a perfect cross surrounded by two smaller cross formations. The larger one was removed intact to be displayed at the memorial site. A few other items not reported in the news were the 26 small businesses that were destroyed and the impact that therapy and cadaver dogs had on workers and survivors. Cadaver dogs became depressed when they no longer found people so their handlers would hide in the rubble to be found and boost the dogs' spirits. Michael later wrote *No Strings Attached* with Lion Gary Gosney.
