THIS WEEKS PROGRAM

Lion Past President Sam Farrow introduced Lee Peterson with the Temple Economic Development Corporation. Mr. Peterson gave us an overview of the many new business coming to Temple as well as the business already in Temple that are expanding. Wilsonart International is the largest manufacturing employer in Temple with over 1,600 employees. Scott & White, one of the largest medical systems in the country employees over 8,000. By 2010 Gulf States Toyota will be coming to Temple and will produce over 10,000 cars to a five state region each month. Also Gulf States Toyota will bring over 500 jobs to Temple. Mr. Peterson gave us an update of the Temple Industrial Park and the additions of rail service to the park. Within a 180 mile radius of Temple there are over 17 and a half million customers who could do business in Temple. Temple is situated in a good proximity to I-35, has good rail availability and air service within 20 miles making Temple an ideal site of business looking to locate in Temple.
