The Temple Founder Lions Club currently sends \$1,000 per month to the CTCC. Recently, many of your Lion brothers have put their "back into it" by helping to clear space at the CTCC for future expansion.

The mission of the Central Texas Children's Center is to provide educational, hibilitative and social programs to children and their siblings who have been identified as having special needs.

In 1965, the current facility at 2000 W. Marlandwood Rd, replaced an even older wooden building on W. Ave H at a cost of \$90,000. Project BRACE, as it was called, was a 4 year project by the Temple Lions Club to raise funds for this new building. BRACE stood for "Build a Rehabilitation Center".

We as Lions need to be proud of our heritage and need to continue to give and to support the needs of children in Bell County.
