The Lighthouse Family Network was conceived in the heart of Leona Lambert in 1969 when she opened her home and family to a five-year-old boy whose mother was unable to care for him. Leona was convinced that with each child was an opportunity to show God's love and one more chance to do it right. She believed that all children deserve a chance and she gave her life to that end. The Lighthouse Family Network operates out of Salado and serves over 100 children. The mission statement of Lighthouse Family Network is "to provide a safe, loving and structured family environment for children in which to grow, mature and experience the love of God." Most children receiving assistance for Lighthouse Family Network is due to family neglect and or violence. Great program.
