The Military Child Education Coalition is a 501 ©(3) non-profit organization that exists solely to help the military child thrive in the face of transition and separation.

There are over 4 million children and youth with parents serving in the Active Duty, National Guard and Reserve Forces, as well as those post 9/11 Veterans.

Military kids move 6-9 times during their K-12 education, and change schools 3x more often than their civilian peers. Over 80% attend public schools, less than 8% attend DOD schools.

The MCEC is dedicated to ensuring inclusive, quality educational experiences for all military-connected children affected by mobility, family separation, and transition.
