Recently Mr. Hightower and four other men sailed from Galveston towards Key West, Florida, an eight hundred mile trim. A storm hit one hundred eighty-six miles from Key West, Florida. The rudder broke off the boat during the storm. Mr. Hightower got on his radio and called "may day" and the boat was taking on water. Another boat heard the distress call and notified the Coast Guard. A Coast Guard Helicopter found Mr. Hightower and his crew aboard his boat, however Mr. Hightower declined rescue and the Coast Guard Helicopter left. The crew of the boat built a rudder and a cutter towed them to Key West Florida. Interesting story of the seas.
