**THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM:** Lion Hamby introduced our State Rep Ralph Sheffield. Rep Sheffield was one of 21 freshman reps in the 81<sup>st</sup> session. He was born in Waco and graduated Richfield High School. At age 19, he owned his first restaurant!!

He has owned and operated Las Casas since 1982. He has received numerous awards and served in numerous offices within restaurant organizations. In 2002-03, he was President of the TX Restaurant

Assoc. He has been named Small Businessman of the Year. He served his first term in a House occupied by 76 republicans and 74 democrats and was the freshman class President. His primary focus this past term was to build relationships and learn "the ropes". There were 7000 bills filed and only 1500 got through. Unfortunately, "chubbing" caused the voter ID bill to die without being heard. The Legislature passed a budget of \$178 billion. This was a 1.9% **decrease** and only the second time this has occurred since WWII. Stimulus money received by the State was used only for one time projects, protecting us from footing the bills for future years for long term projects. TX has a "rainy day" fund of \$9.1 billion!! What do you think of that CA and FL? Rep Ralph managed to get 6 of the 10 bills he carried passed. Thanks, Rep.Sheffield!
