This week we welcomed to our club Ryan Holler & Shannon Myers with TEF. The Temple Education Foundation supports both Temple ISD teachers & students. Through community funding, TEF provides financial resources that enrich teaching and inspire learning for all students in the district.

Student scholarships promote post-secondary success through dual credit tuition reimbursement & academic scholarships. Students received more than \$36,500 in scholarships from the Temple Education Foundation and more than \$23,700 in scholarships managed by the TEF.

This year Temple ISD teachers were awarded \$55,623.27 in grants for innovative projects and plans to improve the quality of a Temple education. Grants may fund classroom materials; parent involvement programs; continuing education workshops; or any activity that supports student academic achievement.

As the program continues to grow, the TEF supports a perpetual endowment that will continue future endeavors to support TISD teachers and students for years to come.
