To be constructed on 55 acres at the Killeen Civic & Convention Center, it will be a place of mourning & remembrance. Initial plans envision a gazebo nestled among 13 trees, symbolizing the deceased, & one small tree for the unborn infant. Funding will come from the generous support & donations of businesses, public & private entities, schools, churches, civic groups, youth groups, etc. VFW is making a \$10,000 contribution next week. TX Power and Light and the Master Gardeners group have expressed their sponsorship interest.

The total cost is currently projected at \$200,000. SPJST is spearheading the project, as one of Lion Vanicek's coworkers came to him with the idea. The first organizational mtg will be 2/24 at the Center. Thanks Lion Brian and Connie.
