Thank you to Mayor Covington for inviting UMHB Crusaders head Coach Pete Fredenburg as our program today.

Coach Fredenburg spoke briefly about this year's Stagg Bowl where the Cru fell to Mount Union 12-0. It was UMHB's first loss since December 2015, which unfortunately broke their 29-game winning streak. It was a tuff defeat not only because of the loss of a National Championship, but it was also the final game for 13 seniors.

UMHB is the highest ranked American Southwest Conference program in this year's fall standings, and is ranked the 22<sup>nd</sup> athletic program in division III.

Here's an interesting quiz that will really make you think. You don't have to actually answer the questions. Just ponder on them straight through, and you'll get the point.


- 1. Name the five wealthiest people in the world.
