THIS WEEKS PROGRAM

Lion Dr. Neil Graeff introduced Lion Diane Waite who gave us a presentation and a quiz on the Texas Lions Camp in Kerrville. The Texas Lions Camp was established in 1949 to provide a summer camp for children with special needs and serves approximately 1800 campers per year. Campers are able to go and the only cost to them and their families is getting there. Even that cost, with high gas prices, was offset last year by giving each family a \$100. The camp is specially equipped with the resources and staff to take care of children with diabetes, physical disabilities, and other limitations. It also provides the parents with programs to help them in caring for these children. The camp itinerary involves a myriad of activities such as a rope course, swimming, sports, and fun learning all culminating in an awards ceremony on the final night of camp. Our club serves hamburgers to the campers on this night and then attends the awards ceremony. The ceremony is something that you must see to get the full appreciation for what we do as Lions. Our club has been a 100% sponsor for the last 28 years and more recently a 200% sponsor. As individuals, we can support the camp by becoming a Century Club member, of which our own **Lion Glenn Brandt** is a charter member! We can also support Lions Camp by purchasing license plates and by participating in work days at the camp.
