Today, the Temple College Men's Basketball Coach, Kirby Johnson visited our club! Coach Johnson is now in his 33rd season as the head men's basketball coach at Temple College and his 43rd season in his coaching career. Coach Johnson informed us that this is his last season as he plans to retire. Since Johnson's tenure began, the Temple College Men's Basketball Team has compiled a record of 691-299. Johnson has an overall coaching record of 800-353 which includes his five seasons as the basketball coach at Temple High School. Johnson is ranked first in the state of Texas in wins for Division 1 NICAA

Coaches. His teams at Temple College have played 988 games and scored 99,803 points, which is an average of 101 points per game, have won 20 or more games in a season in 24 separate seasons, and have 3 Conference Championships. Temple College has the most points scored (173) in a game in NJCAA history, has been the NJCAA National Scoring Champion 12 times, and has made the regional playoffs 28 out of the 30 years of the regional tournament history. In the last 32 years, Temple College Men's Basketball has had players play for University of Texas, Texas Tech, Baylor, SMU, Texas A & M, TCU, University of Cincinnati, Providence, University of North Texas, University of South Alabama, Middle Tennessee State, Northern Arizona, Texas State, University of Texas Pan American, Southeast Louisiana, Fresno State, Indiana State, University of Missouri-Kansas City, Prairie View A & M, University of Maryland Baltimore County, and Grambling, just to name a few. Coach Johnson has been married for 40 years to his wife Kim who is a physical therapist at Scott & White. They have four children and seven grandchildren.
