Our guest speaker today was Gill Eckrich. Gill was born in Germany and moved to Texas in 1964. He entered into the US Army as an infantry officer after graduating from college in 1970. Gill retired as a Lieutenant Colonel after 20 years of service around the globe. Next, he settled

here, where he taught state & fed government courses for 20 years at Central Texas

College before retiring from there in 2009. Additionally, Gill was a wildlife biologist for the Fort Hood Natural Resources Management Branch for 22 years, retiring in 2013.

Gill spoke to us about numerous species of birds found in Ecuador and along the equator. He had photos & stores to tell about many of the categories of birds.

Some Lions got the Long-wattled Umbrellabird confused with the Cock-of-the-rock, but had no trouble with recognizing the Blue-footed Booby. Thank you Ruben for inviting Gill back to the club. Thursday, March 8, Bob Farrell's home caught fire. There was substantial fire damage as well as extensive smoke & heat damage.
