THIS WEEKS PROGRAM

Lion Past President J. W. Perry introduced Temple Fire & Rescue Chief Lorenzo Wallace. On May 10 (this Saturday) the citizens of Temple will vote on a bond package for the Temple Fire Department. The bond amount is for 13.95 million dollars. If approved by voters this would increase your taxes \$ 15.00 per year for a home valued at \$ 100,000.00. Part of this package would be to build a new central fire station in the downtown fire district. Also the Emergency Operations Center would be relocated from city hall to this new station. This would replace the 3rd street station, which was built in 1964. Also a new fire station (Station #8) would be built in the northern part of the city. Station #8 would also be a training facility. Two new trucks would also be purchased. The Temple Fire Department is now entering its 125th year of service to the city of Temple. The Temple Fire & Rescue Department serves a 70 square mile area and made over 10,000 calls in 2007. Nearly 80% of the calls made in 2007 were health related. Thanks Chief Wallace for this program.
