He helps them with things like replacing basketballs, footballs, and other items and is the neighborhood fixer of bicycles, trampolines, and bumps and bruises. Kids really gravitate to him. The thought of these kids not having any where to constructively spend their time in a world of temptation and peer pressure has motivated him to form the Un-included Club, an organization very much in its infancy and in need of help. The motto of this club is "negativity is not an option."
