#### THIS WEEKS PROGRAM

**Lion Neil Graeff** introduced **Lewis Parker** who is with Communities in School (CIS), a non-profit agency that specializes in the individual case management of students who find themselves in challenging situations. CIS is very much like a Big Brother-Big Sister type of organization and children are often referred by both parents and teachers. Mr. Parker, a graduate of UMHB, is assigned to Bonham Middle School. CIS believes that every child needs a one-on-one relationship with a caring adult, a healthy start and a healthy future, a marketable skill to use upon graduation, and a chance to give back to peers and the community. The five components of CIS are supportive guidance, health and human services, parental/family guidance, career awareness, and educational enhancement. Mr. Parker has over 134 students involved in activities and events including United Way spirit chain, Gifts for Families, Academic Stimulus Package, Thanksgiving Baskets, Wash-a-palooza, Field trips to UT and A&M, and Pennies for Parents. They are constantly looking for ways to raise funds and provide service to the community.
