THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM: Filling in for the ailing Lion (too many prefixes to put them all in) Stout, Lion 3rd VP Glenn Brandt introduced Dist. Gov. Lion C.C. Sirkel, Jr., Waco Founder's Club. Lion Sirkel was born in Eldorado TX. He held all levels of offices in the now defunct Heart of TX Club. He then joined the Waco Founder's Club & served as President there. There are only 4 Founders Clubs in TX—Austin, San Antonio, Temple & Waco. He has been busy visiting Clubs in the Dist. He recently attended the convention in Minneapolis. "It was impressive & expensive. I still don't know what I ate for breakfast one day, but it cost \$20, so I choked it down". The new International Pres. was installed. Tradition has been that the outgoing Pres. is given a gift for his/her service, generally in the range of \$35 to \$50K. New Pres. declined. Did he set an example for future Presidents?

Lion Sirkel brought us news of a likely Lions State Headquarters building, which will house a Lions museum, in Kerrville, a district level Club award for the Club with the largest membership increase (\$250 brick at TX Lions Camp), a new state secretary, Sandi Merritt, an upcoming proposal to use unspent monies from past Dist. Gov's budgets to fund contributions to 5 Lions charities, next Lions International Convention may be in Dallas where the original Lions Charter was signed 100 years ago. Membership growth remains a major concern. However, TX is down only 12 members rather than the hundreds of past years.
