Our Hospice House



Dr. Bates returned to the Lions Club to talk about an ongoing work of his 501c(3) - The Lord's Work. He is working with an Advisory Board to get a Hospice House operational in our area. The hospice house is a community home for living and dying where no one has to die alone. Its mission is to provide around-the-clock-level care in a peaceful, compassionate environment where one can die with dignity, comfort, and grace while being cared for with love—at no cost to those in need. I overheard he came to speak with us because something about a target-rich environment. I didn't get it. I guess he and Ray Harper go together like peanut butter and jelly.

The word "Hospice" derives from Latin *hospitum*, meaning hospitality or place of rest and protection for the ill and weary.

The sur name Popelka is a Czech nickname for someone who was neglected or overlooked; a form of the word *popel*, meaning ashes. I guess that explains Billy's nickname, Cinderella. We always appreciate our guests!
