## THIS WEEKS PROGRAM

Lion 3<sup>rd</sup> Vice President Dr. Charles Pierce introduced Louis Dobbins of the Greene Family Camp, who gave us a history and update on Israel and the rest of Middle East. Incidentally, Greene Family Camp housed over 700 people during the recent hurricane and was named Best Shelter Ever by the American Red Cross.

In this newsletter, I cannot possibly relate the breadth of complex and interesting information provided by Mr. Dobbins. He visits Israel as much as six times per year and his presentation went beyond historical fact and into keen observation and insight. He gave us a brief history of Israel (albeit on steroids) and then discussed the current issues facing Israel. These include a divisive history due to past colonial protectorates (Great Britain, Italy, and France) and due to the religious differences of Muslims, Christians, and Jews: occupation, land and settlements; the need for a Palestinian state; Arab refugees in camps since 1948; Palestinian terror; Israeli repression and security; and access to desalinated water. If you missed this; all I can say is I'm sorry. This was a very interesting program.
