**City of Temple Fire Chief Mitchell Randles was presented with a check for \$250 from TFLC in support of the Elves program.**



Tim Davis-Mayor of the City of Temple spoke with the Temple Founder Lions on Wednesday October 17th. He gave us a great summary of all of things concerning our great city of Temple. Demographics-As of 2016 our population is 79,387. Our city annual budget stands at \$160.5 million and currently employees 850.3 people. We are expected to see a 18% increase in population over the next 10 years. There are approximately 17.6 million within 180 miles of Temple.

Workforce-We have 191,832 jobs in the metropolitan statistical area and a 4.4% average unemployment. There is a 114.7% projected increase in employment by 2025. The median age for our workforce is 34.6 years, median hourly wage is \$15.55 and average annual earnings sits at \$57,000.

General Fund Revenues are 31% Sales Tax, 19% Property Taxes, 19% Solid Waste Fees, 16% Other Charges for Services, 9% Franchise Fees, 3% Fines, 2% Other Revenues and 1% Licenses/Permits.

We have \$237,734,750 in our Capitol Improvement Program. This is divided by 31% RX, 30% Utility, 21% TCIP, 10% Parks and 8% Others. Projects that were completed, scheduled or underway by 12-31-18 are: Reinvestment one, Transportation CIP, Utility CIP, Parks Bond, Drainage CIP and Faculty CIP.
