THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM: Czech it out! Lion Pres. Ray

gave a lengthy intro (what a wordsmith) to our speaker, Lion Vanicek. He presented a program on the upcoming Czech Heritage celebration, 10/31 at Miller Park. It's an all day affair with bands, car show, carnival & midway, Miss Texas performing, and much more. \$5 for adults, children under age 12-free. Czech immigrants settled in the blackland area of TX in the mid 1800s. They brought with them a culture over 27,000 years old, a strong work ethic, commitment to community, and sugar cubes (you had to be there).. Their sense of pride in their community and property was coupled with their willingness and determination to achieve. They founded a benevolent association, the SPJST, in 1897 in Fayette County. SPST has as its major goal service to the community. (Sorta like the Lions, only they have money and can sell insurance!). Today there are 114 SPJST lodges in TX. Our local lodge has acquired a new property at 3rd and French. They plan to expand the museum and move in by the first Monday in December. Come on out on 10/31, wear your costumes; it sounds like great fun and informative.

To top off today's program, Lion Vanicek again brought us the Czech spelling bee. The words were Czech names from the telephone book. Contestants were Lion Grady Tyroch, Lion Gary Gosney, Lion Gary Jones, and Lion David Fette. (what a crew!)
