Past Lion President Allen Lueck introduced our program this week. Welcoming Temple Community Clinic director Sherri Woytek. In his introduction he stated that he knew that “Sherri was sent to the Clinic from God!”

Sherri took early retirement from Bank of America and was happy at home for about 18 months. Her love for nonprofit involvement and community service led her to her new position as the clinic director and out of “early retirement”. She had been president of Altrusa and had served on multiple boards, including Temple Community Clinic and United Way of Central Texas.

Temple Community Clinic is a community-based organization providing free health care to the working poor, qualified uninsured and those with overwhelming medical debt in the Bell County area since 1992, which was the Leadership Temple project. The clinic is dedicated to addressing more than just the physical needs of the patients by innovative high-quality services including health education and research. The goal of Temple Community Clinic is to be a focal point of compassion and caring in the City of Temple.

The Clinic is staffed by highly qualified volunteer physicians, nurses and dentists from Scott & White Memorial Hospital and Clinic and various private practices. Volunteers from community organizations and the business community assist with office responsibilities. There are now day clinics, night clinics and specialty clinics. The specialty clinics include dental, podiatry, cardiology, gynecology, dermatology and gastrointestinal. Patients who come to the regular clinic can be referred to a specialty clinic if it's determined they need to see a specialist. Nursing students from UMHB and Temple College also spend time at the clinic.

Temple Community Clinic major fund raiser is the annual “Caring Ball” to held on the 2nd Saturday in February, 2014. **SAVE THE DATE!**
