THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM: Lion Jim (moustachio'ed mayor) intro'ed Coach Fred Fredenburg, head coach of the Division III 3rd ranked UMHB **Blue Cru**. His varsity traveling squad of 60 will kick off their season this Sat in Bethany OK against Southern Nazarene. Southern has the advantage of already having played a game. As usual, the Cru's chief rival appears to be Hardin Simmons, who they will play in Abilene 10/03. They are currently ranked #4 behind UMHB. This is the Cru's 12 season. They have 180 players on varsity and JV. 136 came in on this year's freshman class. There are 82 returning players. UMHB must compete against Div II schools who can offer scholarships. Coach has two freshmen who are expected to make an immediate impact this year. The CRU has won the conference title the past 4 years with non-scholarship kids who want to play for UMHB and live the lifestyle of the University. Coach reported he was ably assisted by Larry Harmon, defensive coordinator, David Branscom, defensive coach, Matt Robinson, offense coordinator, George Hafner, offense coach, Joe George, offense line coach, and Jeff Shinn, who scored UMHB's very first touchdown!! Coach also has 5 graduate assistants and 5 student assistants. Coach's most memorable moment was the "snow bowl" victory against Mt. Union. At that time, they had not lost in their home stadium since 1995. UMHB has one former player in the CFL.
