Today, TFLC heard from the UMHB Mayborn College of Health Sciences Executive Dean, Dr. Colin Wilborn. Fall 2019 marks the beginning of Dr. Wilborn's 14th year as a leader at UMHB. The Mayborn College of Health Sciences was created in July of 2018 to promote a collaborative, interprofessional environment necessary for training healthcare professionals to provide comprehensive medical care. Housed within the college is the School of Exercise and Sport Science, which includes undergraduate and graduate degree programs in Exercise Physiology, Health Science,



Sports Administration & Sports Management, and EC-12 Physical Education; the Scott & White School of Nursing; and the School of Health Professions, which includes the Doctor of Physical Therapy program, the Master of Arts in Counseling program, the Master of Science in Occupational Therapy program starting in the Spring of 2020, and the Master of Science in Physician



Assistant program starting in the Spring of 2021. The Cru Community Clinic, an on-campus building renovated by UMHB to provide physical therapy, occupational therapy, and counseling services to the community for underserved populations will open soon. The clinic will allow UMHB to serve the Central Texas community that has supported the university for almost 175 years!
