There are 5,750 hospitals in Texas and only 250 pediatric hospitals. Experts recommend that children be treated at a children's hospital. There are many reasons. Children have growth plates, so X-rays are different for children. Chil-

dren have smaller blood cells and their blood levels are much less than adults. Medication and dosages are very different for children as well. Not to mention that some drugs taste bad and need to the taste to be masked. So they use spays instead of needles and liquids instead of pills. These are just some of the issues that make a children's hospital so important. One out of every 11 children in America live in Texas. Texas has the second highest birth rate in the country. 25% of the children in Texas live at, or below the poverty level. Texas has the dubious honor of having the highest percentage of uninsured children, about 16%. Before McLane Children's Hospital 43% of our local children had to travel elsewhere for service, Now children come here from all over the state.

McLane Children's is close to it's 4th birthday. They employee close to 1,000 people.
