On July 1, 1862, President Lincoln signed the second revenue measure of the Civil War into law. This law levied internal taxes and established a permanent internal tax system. Congress established the Office of the Commissioner of the Internal Revenue under the Dept. of Treasury. On July 17, 1862, George Boutwell became its first commissioner. It's first year—1863—it collected \$39.1 million.
