When metals burn, they can create flames in various colors. Fire-changing color packets capitalize on this reaction by placing trace amounts of the various metals into packets. When placed on the fire, the trace metals burn, creating the colored-flames, until the base metals no longer remains. Baking soda does not change the color of flames, but it can extinguish them. Epsom salt creates white flames.
