➤ TODAY'S LIONS PROGRAM

We appreciate Lion Michelle for bringing an interesting program this week with John Lacy, the Chief Human Resources Officer of Baylor Scott & White Health. John joined BSWH in November 2014 and oversees all human resource functions for the organization. He is developing a Service Center in Temple to support human resources for their 36,000 employees.

John comes to Temple from Baptist Memorial Health Care Corp in Memphis, TN where he served as VP Human Resources. He spent a total of fifteen years at BMHCC in progressive leadership roles. Prior to that he held roles as Sr. VP Human Resource at Methodist Health System in Dallas, TX and Memorial Health Market in Jacksonville, FL.

John's main goal in this position is to help people with their employment, career development, and conflict resolution. Baylor and Scott & White coming together was a very important step to place them in the forefront with resources, quality of service, size, and scale that can serve large populations in these new times of change for health care. Construction has begun of an HR Service Center in Temple that will provide assistance for all employees. Also, this will add 40+ jobs to our area. BSWH is building their headquarters to house Corporate Officers, Legal, and IT.

John shared that the workforce dynamics are changing. With a larger group of retirees that worked traditional 8 to 5 hours, the younger workforce prefers more flexible hours and an ability to work from home. This plays a huge part in the changes along with new technology. They are constantly reviewing new devices to improve communication and delivery of information through iPhones, iPads, etc... which improves the ease and efficiency of individuals.
