Comprehensive training and counseling creates a strong foundation for healthy independent living. Drawing from the vast array of services at Lions World Services for the Blind (LWSB), a training

schedule for each person's needs is designed to achieve a well-rounded and healthy personal adjustment to visual disability.

The philosophy of LWSB training maintains that effective and total rehabilitation can only be achieved in a therapeutic multi-disciplinary environment that is found in a comprehensive residential rehabilitation center. Home visits can substitute for the residential training when working with persons in the area who are elderly and visually impaired.

All persons who are elderly and losing vision need a professional to help with the life changes they're experiencing. The ultimate goal for LWSB of ElderCare Project is to train the elderly to remain as independent for as long as possible.
