➤ **TODAY'S LIONS PROGRAM**

A big thanks to the Mayor for joining us for lunch and providing an update to city projects. Topics he covered:

- Population Growth- more than doubled since 1970
- Economy – Sales Tax Revenue up, Unemployment lower than state and national average, less than 4%
- New housing has almost doubled over last year
- NW Loop 363 – Completed Feb 15, largest single CIP project ever undertaken by City
- Developed a Transportation Capital Improvement Program to support existing road improvement. Great example is the Western Hills Project, where money was budgeted to update utility, wastewater, and roadways
- Panda Energy – Developed ways to provide reclaim water to Panda, supporting the largest private project in the region and increase revenue to the water and wastewater utility
- Buc – ees – Beaver nuggets coming soon
- Downtown Redevelopment underway to improve blighted conditions, historic buildings
- Santa Fe Market Days – opening April 4th, every Saturday from 9 to 1
- Program Overview – designed to equip volunteer groups with the tools and the support to host successful neighborhood cleanup events. City provides a toolbox trailer with the needed equipment and a junktrunk dumpster for removal of debris, beginning April 1st. www.templetx.gov/cleanup.
- Park Bond Election - May 9, 2015

Danny Dunn was elected to his first term as Mayor in May, 2013. Previously, he has served on the Temple City Council, District 1 since May, 2010, and was elected Mayor Pro-Tem in June 2012. He is a real estate broker and vice president of Rodney Dunn Company, Inc., in Temple. He is a graduate of Temple High School and Baylor University.

Mayor Dunn is active in many civic organizations. He is currently a vice chair and a member of the Temple Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, chair of the Killeen-Temple Metropolitan Planning Organization and is a member of the AUSA Central Texas Chapter board of governors. He is past president of the Rotary Club of Temple, past chair of the Temple Education Foundation and past chair of the City of Temple's Building and Standards Commission. Mayor Dunn also served as a member of the city's Parks and Leisure Services Advisory Board and the Strategic Investment Zone Group.

Mayor Dunn and his wife, Alicia both serve on the McLane Children's Hospital Scott and White Board of Visitors and are active members of Christ Episcopal Church.
