Barbara told us about the many ways the [Central Texas Housing Consortium](#) helps impoverished and elderly individuals that need help acquiring housing. I was surprised by the number of properties CTHC owns and manages. However, CTHC does more than just housing.

It's the Central Texas Housing Consortium because the Temple Consortium took over operating the Belton Consortium as well. Over 60% of their annual budget comes from rents collected. Another 20% is made up of grants and government assistance.
