Our guest program today was Mrs. Susan Randles. Susan is the better half of Lion & Temple Fire Chief Mitch Randles. Susan spoke to us about Rescue Elves, a program of Temple Fire & Rescue. This program is designed to bring a little of Christmas into the lives of local children that will not have it otherwise. Rescue Elves started in 2000 under Chief Lonzo Wallace. Today they team with Temple & Belton school districts to identify those in the community with the greatest & most immediate need. The teachers & counselors in the districts know the families that may have recently lost employment or housing. Seventy-five percent of the families benefited by this program are not able to list a permanent address because they have lost their home & are in a transit situation. This service is truly affecting the lives of those who really need a helping hand & works in tandem with the many other wonderful programs in town to prevent replication of aid.
