Jennifer Weir gave us a tour of the newly expanded Bell County Expo Equine/Livestock Complex.

The new 170,000 sq. ft. Equine/Livestock Complex is located on the west side of the campus, adjacent to the existing Horse Barn and Exposition Building. The heart of the new Equine/Livestock Complex will be its 130' x 300' performance surface. It has air conditioning, concourse for vendors with an unrestricted view of the arena, seating for 800 patrons, attached 100' x 200' warm-up arena with stalls and pens, concessions and a bar and grill.

Features: Performance Arena: 130 'x 300' permanent dirt arena, Warm Up Arena: 100' x 200' covered dirt arena, Premium Stalls: 136, Horse Barn stalls: 220 stalls adjacent to existing facility, Stock Pens: 12 20' x 20' pens with permanent alleys adjacent to performance arena, 800 Permanent Seats, Private Meeting Rooms, Priefert Equipped Facility, Dedicated show office, judges quarters and first aid room, Kiser selected footing, built to work well with existing facilities and RV hookups.
