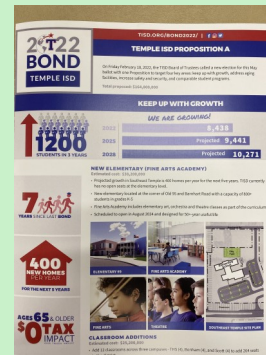

In 1800, Thomas Jefferson was elected President by one vote in the House of Representatives
 1824—Andrew Jackson won the popular vote, but lost by one vote in the House to John Quincy Adams
 1846—Polk's request for Declaration of War against Mexico passed by one vote
 1868—Andrew Johnson was impeached, but not convicted bc the Senate was one vote shy of the necessary 2/3 requirement
 1876—Samuel Tilden won the presidential popular vote, but came up one electoral vote shy and lost to Rutherford B. Hayes
 1962—Governors of Maine, Rhode Island, and North Dakota were elected by an average of one vote per precinct
 2021—Temple ISD's Prop A bond failed 1,967 to 1,965
