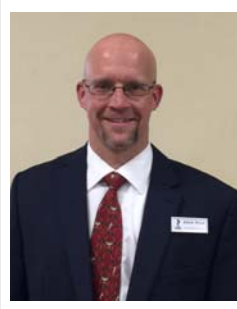

This Week’s Program

Regional director for the Better Business Bureau.

The Better Business Bureau is a private nonprofit organization that’s funded by the business community for the general public. Their goal is to promote ethics in business. They do business reviews, charity reports, dispute resolution, add review,

investigations, and scam alerts. They do investigate national and local charities. Adam serves 79 counties in Texas.

He presented the top 10 scams that the Better Business Bureau tracks:

10. Sweepstakes scam – “you have won a prize and just send the taxes and etc.
9. clickbait scam – “just click below and you will win_____”
8. Robocall scam – “this is Rachel from cardholder services”
7. Government grant scam – “and this is something you did not even apply for”
6. Emergency scam – “a loved one has been hurt or stranded, send money”
5. Medical alert scam – “a loved one is in the hospital, send money”
4. Copycat website scam – “you think you are ordering something online from a reputable company, but the scammers have copied the website in every detail and will take your money and you will receive nothing or inferior merchandise.
3. Are you calling yourself scam – “a call comes to your cell phone from your home phone?”
2. The tech support scam – “you get a call from Microsoft or Dell that says your computer is running slowly and then they take control and get any and all information they want from your computer.”
1. Arrest scam – “you get a call saying you are about to be arrested and you can avoid it by paying your fine to the scammers.
